REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS

- A single movement only from a standard concerto or work for solo instrument and orchestra not to exceed 15 minutes
 - Selection must be memorized
- Contestants must furnish own piano accompanist
Accompanist will not be provided

 - Application fee of \$25 payable to "SEOSO" Refunded only if competition is canceled
- Finalist will be selected and notified via email of their competition date and time by January 15, 2009
Scheduled times are final and cannot be changed after January 15. Please indicate on your application if you require a morning or afternoon time due to conflict
 - Must be received by December 31, 2008
 - Competition will take place Saturday January 17, 2009 - Brown Chapel, Muskingum College, New Concord, Ohio
 - Final live competition is closed, winners will be notified via EMAIL by January 30
